Policy: Quantitative Targets

5 time-bound and 2 open-ended targets

- Establishment of CC Centre within a year;
- Initiation of community-based local adaptation actions as mentioned in NAPA by managing financial resources by 2011;
- Preparation of a national strategy for carbon trade to benefit from CDM by 2012;
- Formulation and implementation of a low carbon economic development strategy by 2014;
- Assessment of loss and benefit from climate change by 2013;
- Promotion of technology development and transfer, public awareness raising, capacity building and access to financial resources; and
- Development of a reliable impact forecasting system.

2012 Activities (As of 25 March 2012)

- NCCSP - Agreement on DFID/EU (16.5m Euro for NAPA profile 1) - 70 plans (LAPA) to be prepared implemented in 14 districts, and possibility for preparing CDM and LCD strategies
- PIF preparation for NAPA profile 2 (Agriculture) - US \$ 3m from LDC Fund (LDCF has now US\$ 15m for each LDC) (in process)
- Assessment of loss and benefits from CC - CDKN support
- Early warning/impact forecasting systems under PPCR/GLOF
- Awareness raising and capacity building - continuous process
- International conference of mountain countries on climate change + expert consultation + parliamentarian workshop - about 25 countries to attend
- Gender and climate change strategy/action plan with IUCN
- Nepal included in USAID ADAPT-ASIA programme
- LDC coordination for 2013-14
- Negotiating team - continuity
