

Call For Proposal: Clean Air Initiative

Clean Energy Nepal invites proposals from Youth groups and/or individuals for local initiatives to curb local air pollution.

Clean Energy Nepal (CEN) invites proposals from local youths to implement **Clean Air initiatives** (Local initiatives) to curb local air pollution in *Kathmandu* under the “Safe and Clean Air for All (SAFA)” Campaign. It is implemented by CEN in eight cities with the support of US Embassy.

The campaign will provide grants to young people (18-35 age group) to work on initiative/s to maintain the clean air. The initiative should focus on curbing air pollution and maintaining clean air through advocacy, technological intervention, awareness and knowledge dissemination among others.

Key Responsibilities

- Share the design, plan and detailed activities of the project.
- Carry out the proposed project at the local level in line with SAFA team.
- Communicate air quality data with local stakeholders and communities.
- In all aspects of project execution, maintaining the integrity of project design, and producing high-quality outputs.
- Regular updates on activities, deliverables, budgets and work plans to SAFA team, and be responsible for conducting working activities independently.
- Support SAFA team in project model related activities in the local area.
- Submit reports: monthly report at the end of every English month and final report after upon the completion of the local initiative.

Key competencies

- At least intermediate/10+2 degree.
- Involvement in volunteering or community development works, with special attention to air pollution-related activities.
- Strong capability to conduct and participate in field-related activities.
- Familiar with spreadsheet data, graphs, tables, and report writing.
- Capable of handling virtual/digital platforms.
- Motivated candidate having time and personnel management skills.
- Flexible, self-motivating, and capable to manage his/her tasks efficiently.
- Capability to work under a pressurized environment.
- Capable to meet deadlines for project accomplishment and reporting.
- Should have problem-solving, program management and implementation skills and ability to conduct the works independently.
